Medical education is the site where we see tremendous possibility for change. We need many and diverse voices to speak to us, so that we may see what resonate for us. Medical humanity (MH) is projected to be the answer to many of the serious, unresolved issues in medical practice. MH is the name generally given to an interdisciplinary programme, drawing largely on the humanities and the arts, that aims to address the emotional, and psychological aspects of medical training not taken care of by the standard undergraduate medical curriculum. In this background Medical Education Unit of JSS Medical College in collaboration with Clinical Development Skills Agency is organizing a two days workshop on Medical Humanities for Interns on 14th and 15th of September 2017.

Objectives of workshop

1. To orient the medical interns on humanistic values in medical care
2. To inculcate the values of humanism through cooperative, team based learning approaches
3. To bring in the concepts of reflective practice in patient care and team building.

Ravi Ramaswamy received training in Theatre of the Oppressed in 2010, from Marc Weinblatt of the Mandala Center for Change. He is a trustee at the Centre for Community Dialogue and Change (CCDC) and has been a Theatre of the Oppressed practitioner and trainer for the last 5 years, leading workshops in schools and colleges, across cities in India.

Since 2014, Ravi has led theatre based workshops in Medical Humanities for faculty and students at the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Bhopal and Jodhpur, JSS Medical College, Mysore, Melaka Manipal Medical College, Manipal, Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Sevagram, Wardha and at National Medical Conferences at Devaraj Urs Medical College, Kolar, MS Ramaiah Medical College, Bangalore and GS Medical College, Mumbai.

In probably the first initiative of its kind in the country, the Department of Prisons, Government of Karnataka, with the NGO Peacemakers, invited Ravi to lead a week long workshop for inmates of Bangalore Central Jail, focusing on their emotional and psychological wellbeing.

With a Masters degree in Social Work and 10 years' experience of working in the development sector, Ravi brings to his theatre pedagogy a deep understanding of issues such as urban poverty, education, child and youth rights, gender and sexuality.
