Forensic Update-2017 is proposed to impart and refresh the knowledge of Clinical practitioners, Medical Officers, Forensic Practitioners, Police Officers and others who are involved in Criminal investigation system. In this one day CME it is planned to have deliberations by expert resource faculty, on relevant medico-legal issues.

This CME is based on legal issues a medical practitioner faces in his day to day practice. Since the violence against doctors and hospital personnel are on rise, legal provisions available for Medicare personnel against violence will be addressed. Medical Audit is a necessary module in Medicare Service Institutions, hence a deliberation on medical audit is planned which will highlight the procedure and difficulties faced in audit. A talk on negligence in medical practice is designed so as to address the practical problems faced by a clinician. Facing the defence in the courtroom is considered to be horrendous by many of the doctors. A talk on how to stand the defence in the witness box is intended wherein the speaker would share the personal experiences in deposing evidence. CME is followed by a panel discussion by all the resource faculty and Superintendent of Police, Sri Ravi D Channanavar.

In view of ever increasing crimes and its percolation into the different strata of the society, awareness about the crime and its investigation to the general public is arranged through two days 'Forensic Fair' in JSS Medical Institutions Campus, SS Nagar, Mysuru.
