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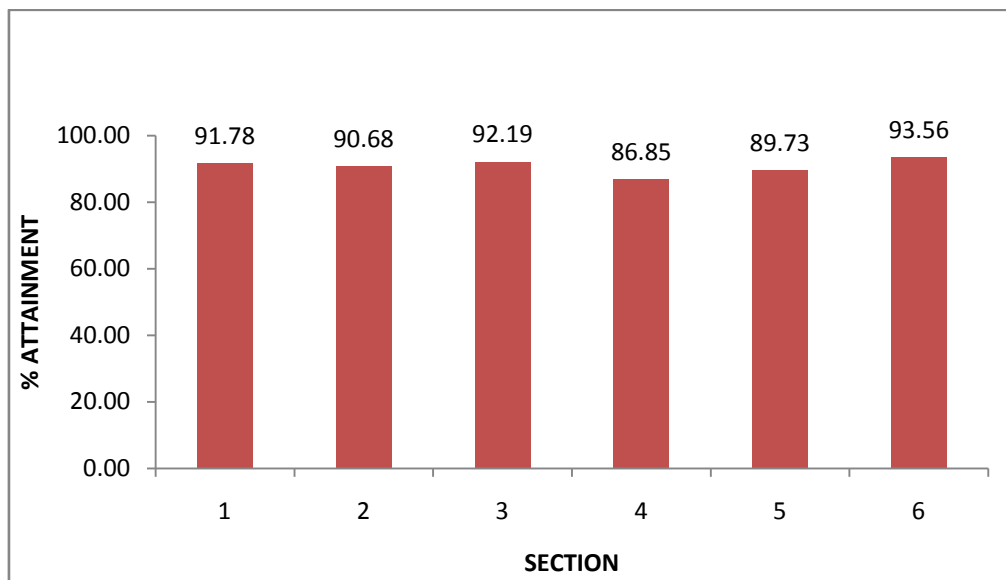

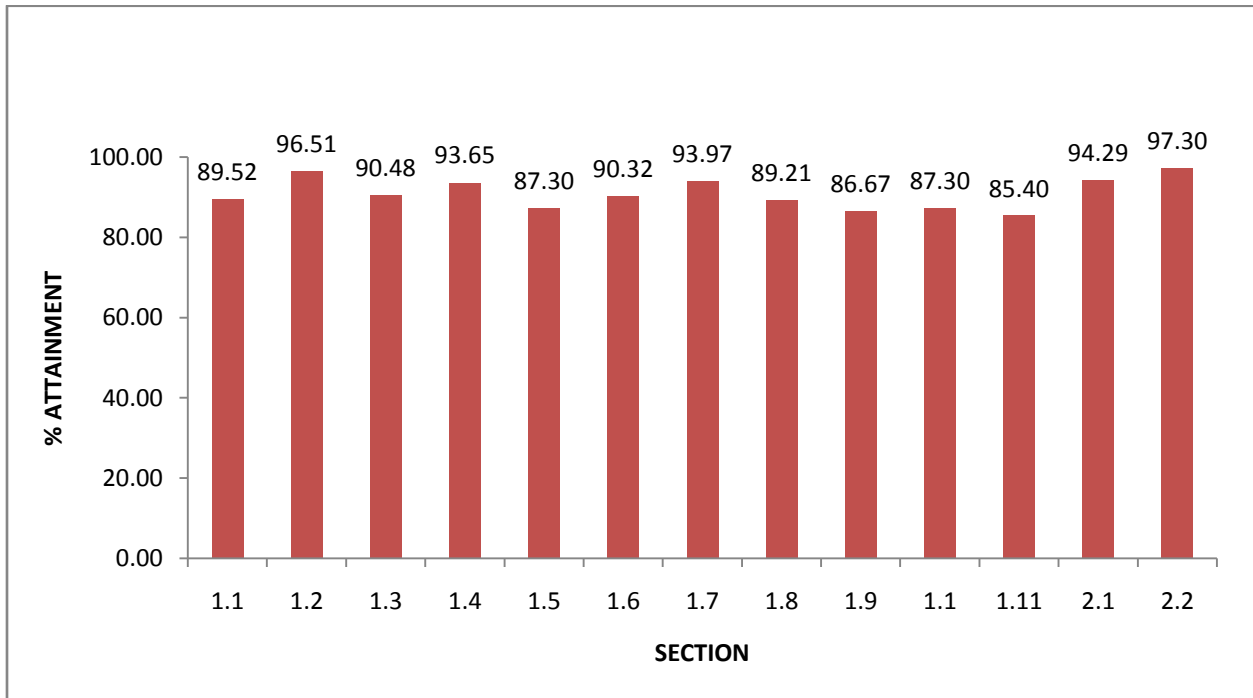
Graph – Graduating student's feedback

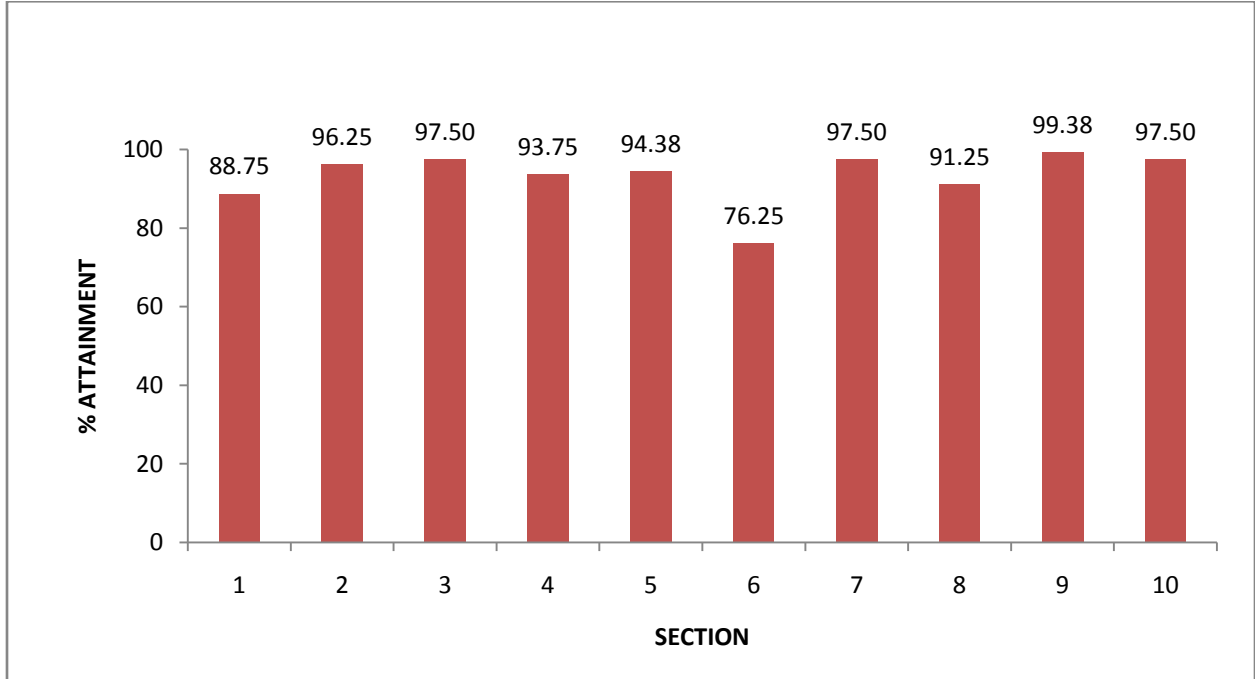
Graph – Alumni's feedback

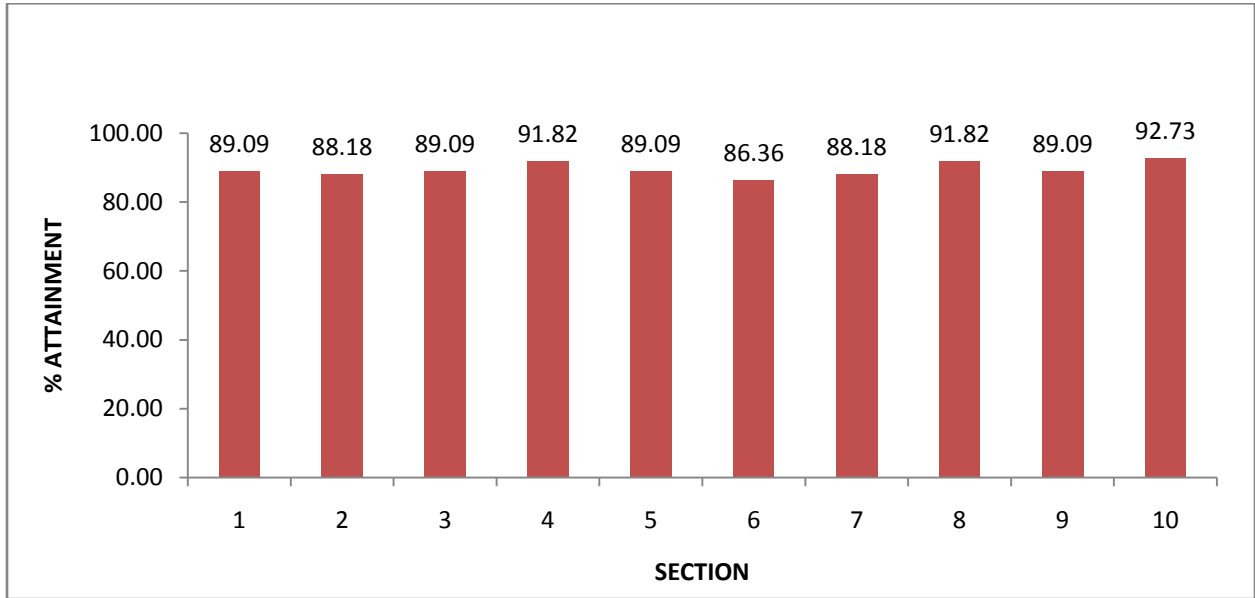
Graph – Teacher’s feedback

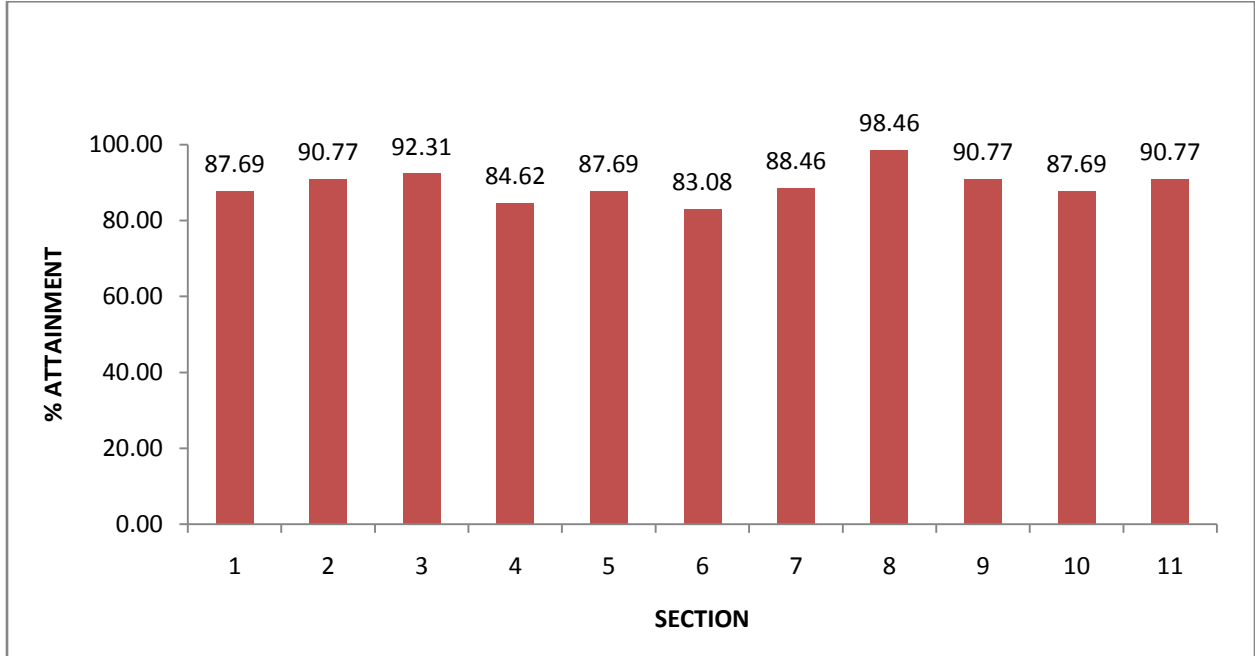
Graph –Parent’s feedback

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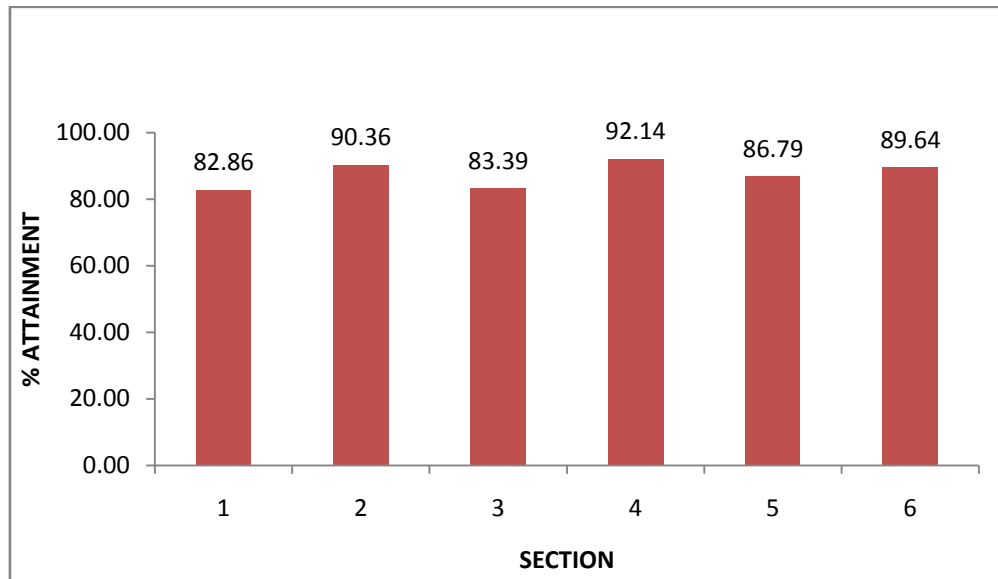

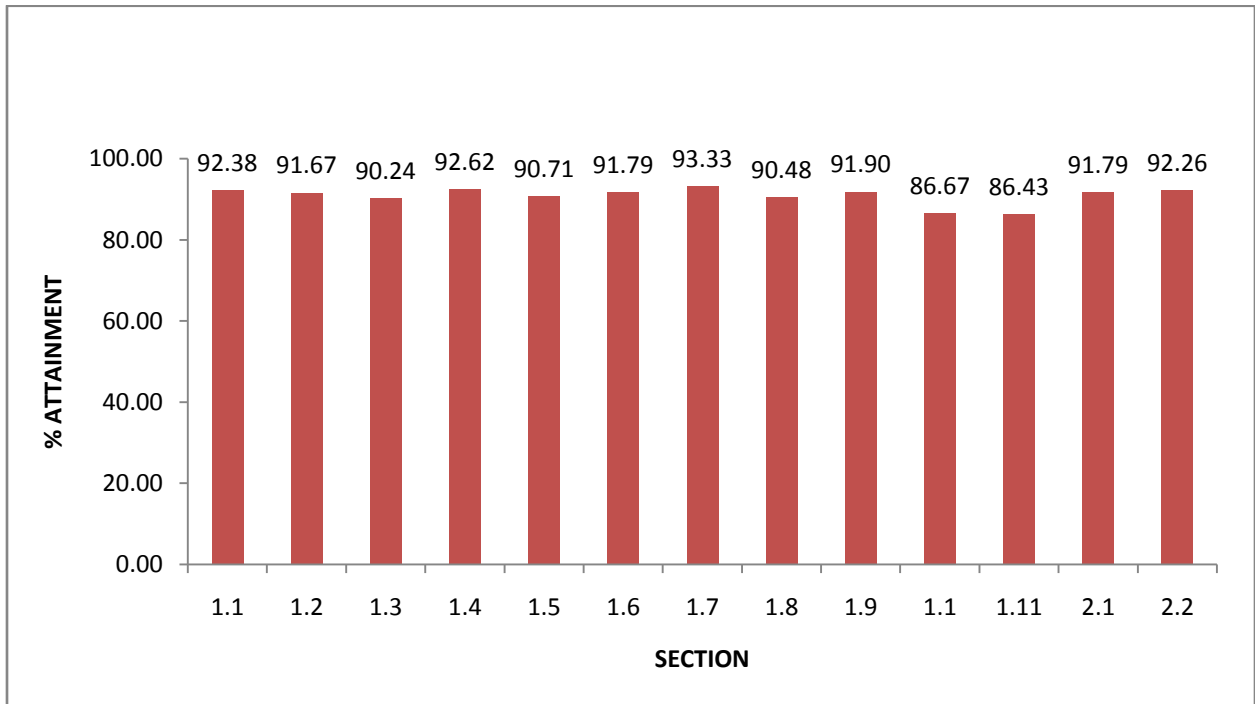
Graph – Graduating student's feedback

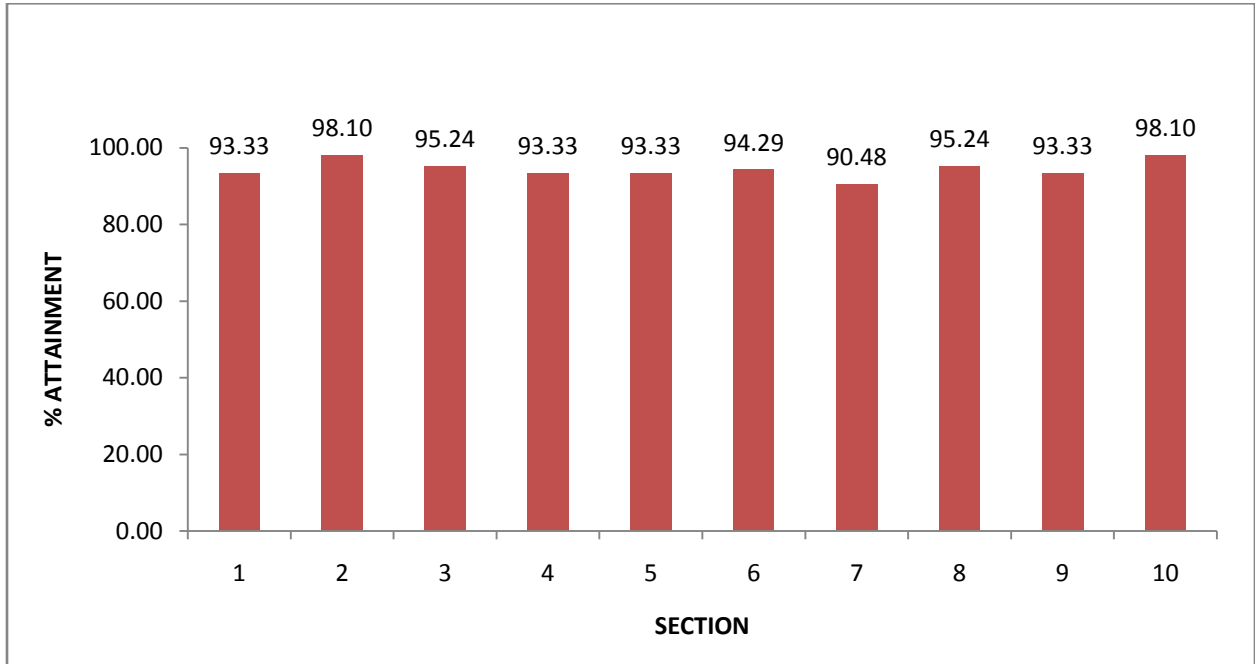
Graph – Alumni’s feedback

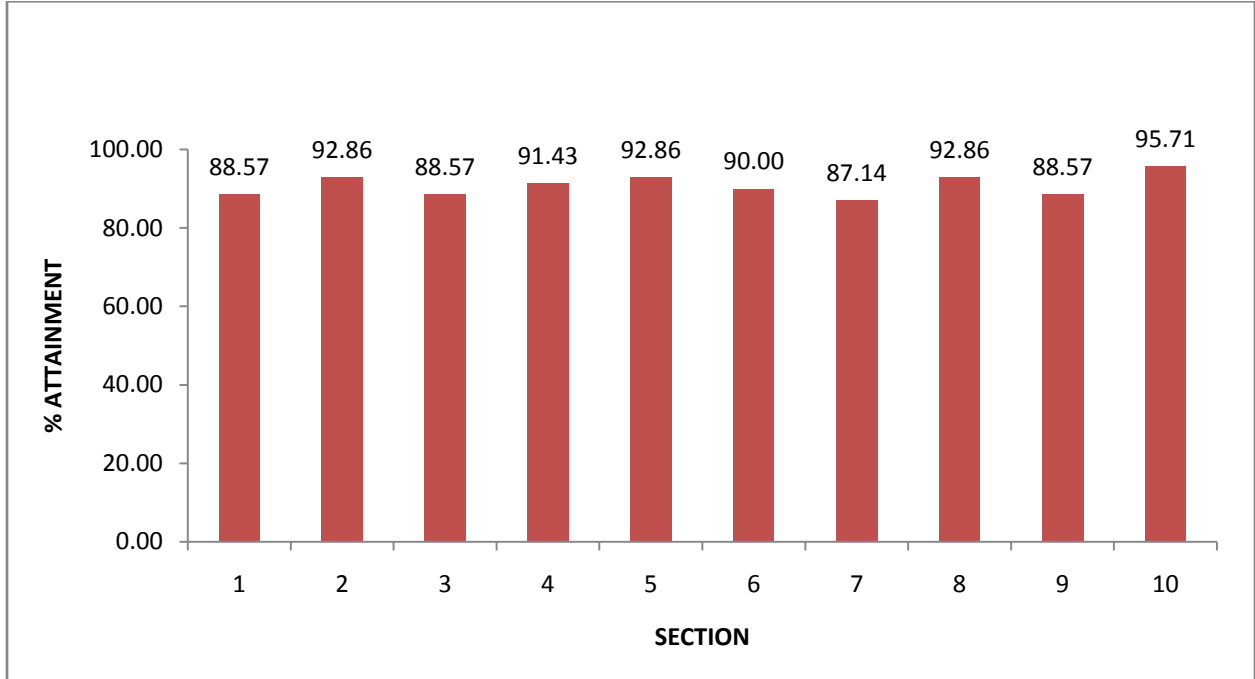
Graph – Teacher’s feedback

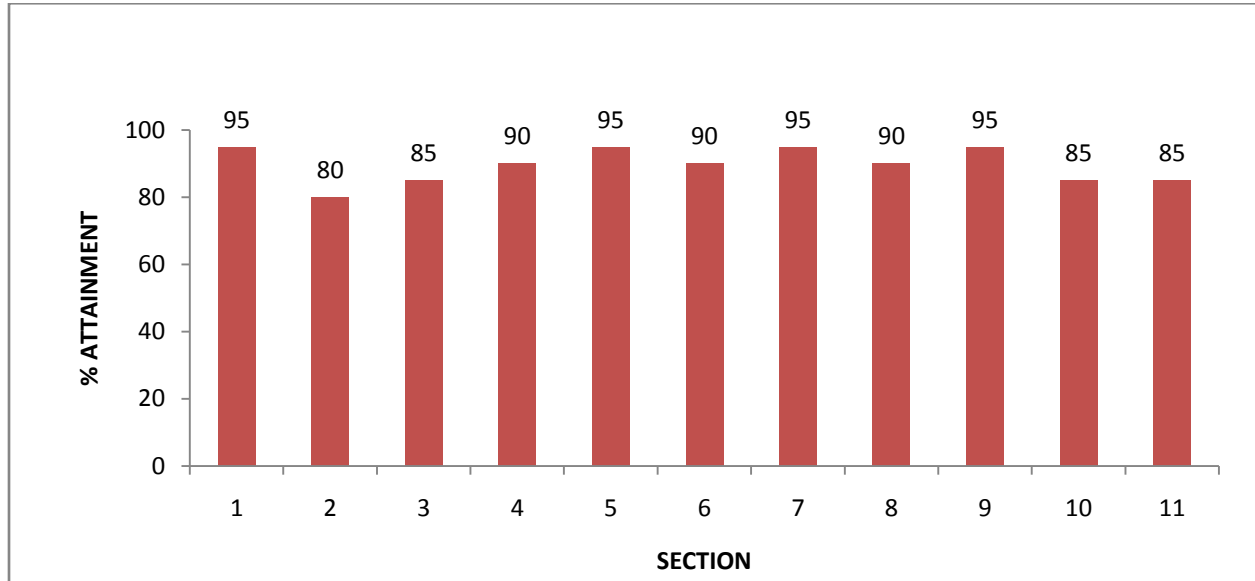
Graph –Parent’s feedback

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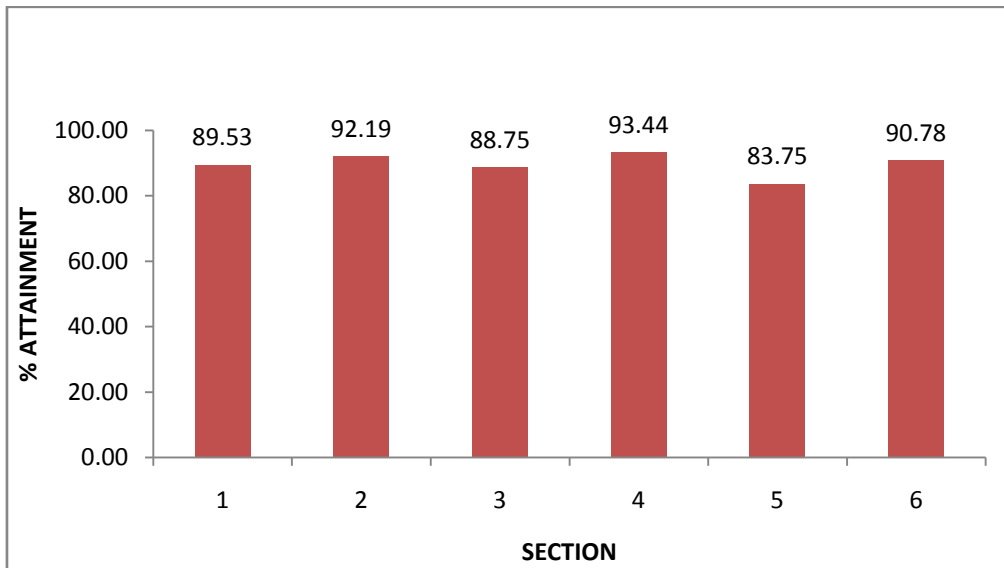

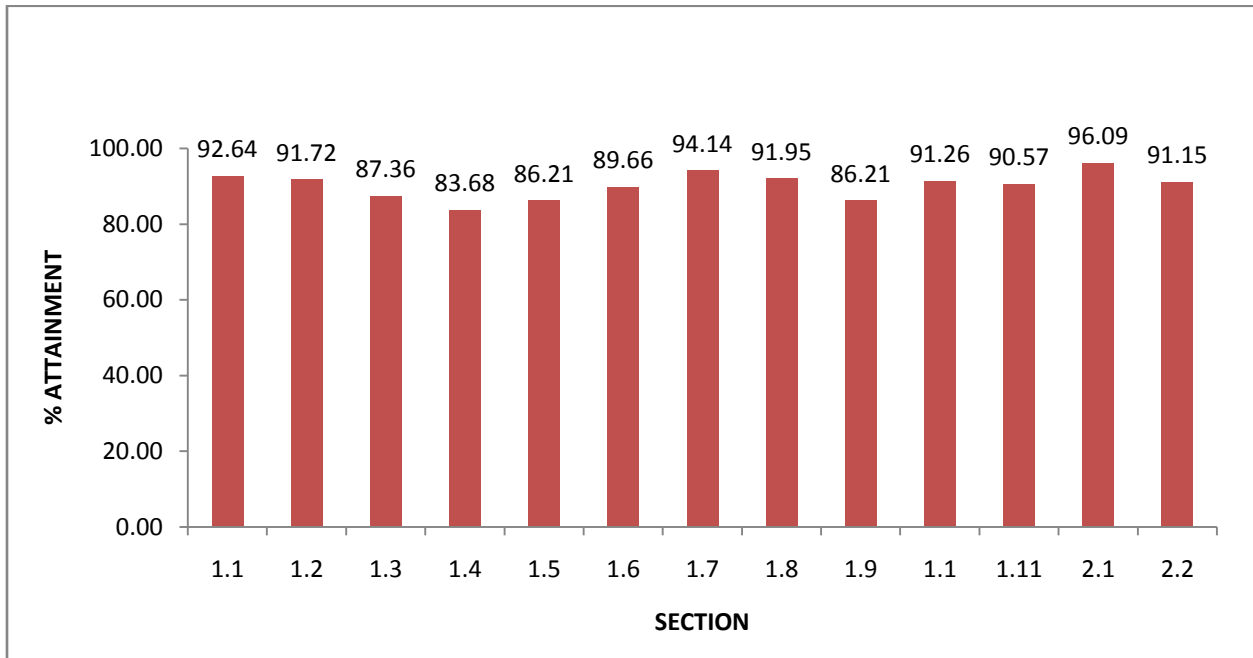
Graph – Graduating student's feedback

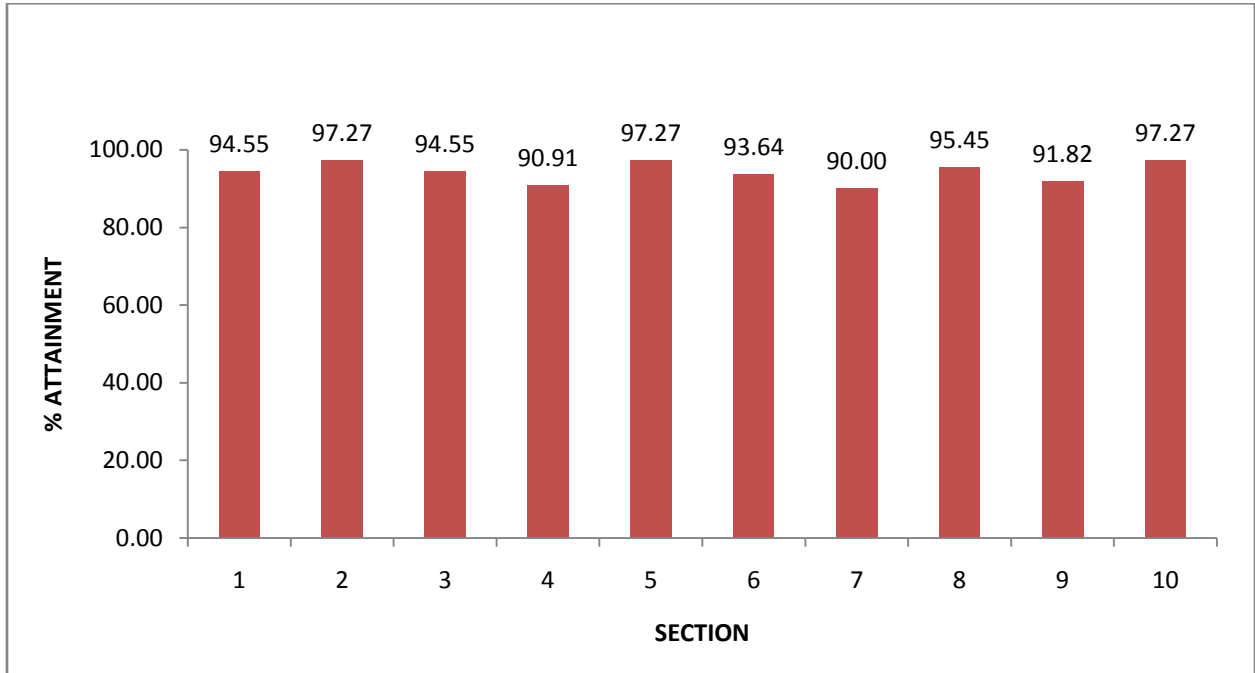
Graph – Alumni's feedback

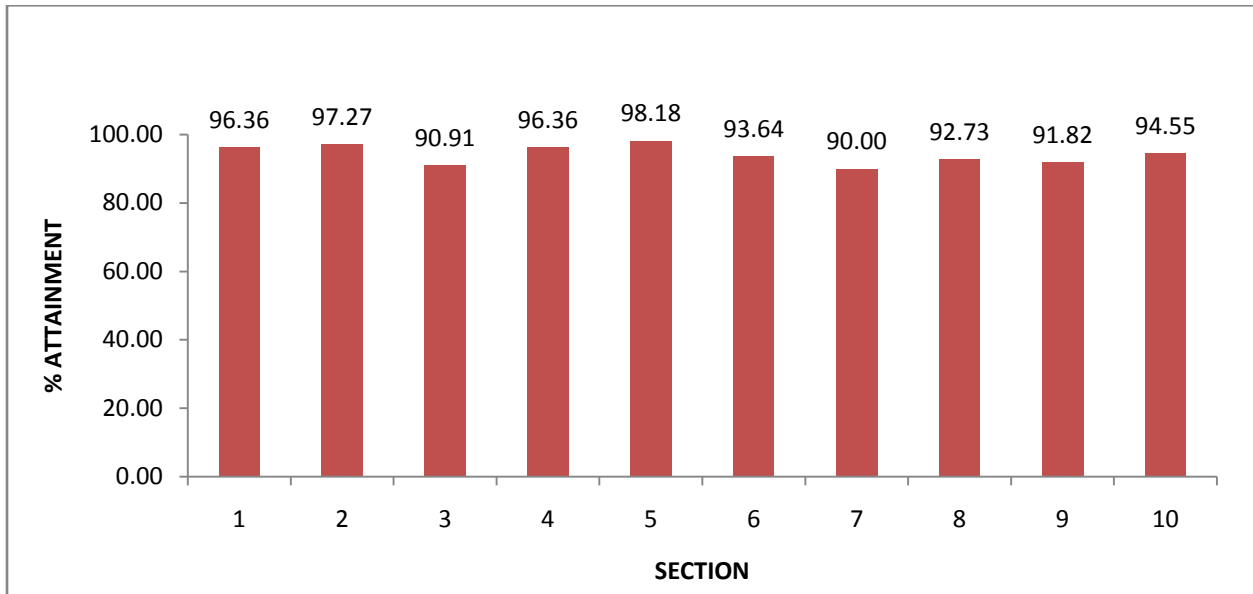
Graph – Teacher’s feedback
