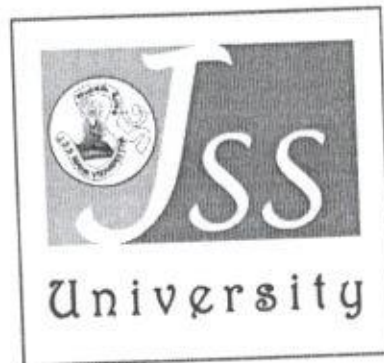

Memorandum of Cooperation between the JSS University, India and the Oman Medical College, Sultanate of Oman





The Oman Medical College (P.O.Box 620, P.C.130, Muscat, Sultanate of Oman, website: www.omc.edu.om) intends to start a post graduate program in Pharmacy in academic partnership with JSS University (Sri Shivarathreswara Nagara, Mysore 57015, website: www.jssuni.edu.in), Mysore, India. On behalf of Dr. P. Mohamed Ali, Chairman, Oman Medical College Governing Council, Dr. Diana Beattie, Dean of Pharmacy & Premedical Studies and Professor M. P. Nair, Chief Financial Officer of the college sign this Memorandum of Academic Partnership with JSS University on the 7th May 2013 to confirm the outcome of discussions held in this regard.

Oman Medical College plans to start a Master of Science program in Clinical Pharmacy after getting necessary approval from the Ministry of Higher Education in Oman. The JSS University has agreed to render its services to develop the program and in other related academic responsibilities. Having discussed this matter with all concerned in Oman as well as at the JSS University, it is agreed that:

1. The Oman Medical College in academic partnership with the JSS University will offer a 2-year Master of Science joint program in Clinical Pharmacy leading to a award of the degree by JSS University.
2. The curriculum for the M.Sc. program in Clinical Pharmacy at OMC will be that of the M. Pharm. program in Pharmacy Practice offered by the College of Pharmacy at the JSS University appropriately modified in the Omani context.
3. In order to support the aforementioned objectives, the JSS University agrees to the following:
 - 3.1. Develop a curriculum jointly with the Oman Medical College and validate the same.
 - 3.2. Award the certificate upon successful completion of the program
 - 3.3. Jointly develop a reasonable and viable physical and human resources plan for the program.
 - 3.4. Develop Quality Assurance standards and regulations for assessment, award of qualification.

- 3.5. Arrange rotations of clinical pharmacy training for OMC students in Mysore and nearby hospitals.
 - 3.6. Enable student and faculty exchanges between JSS University and Oman Medical College.
 - 3.7. Participation of JSS faculty in assessments including final comprehensive examination.
 - 3.8. Undertake joint research programs relevant to Oman.
 - 3.9. Establish a video conference link between JSS University and Oman Medical College subject to feasibility and viability.
4. Oman Medical College agrees to:
 - 4.1. Obtain all necessary permits and support from the government of Oman.
 - 4.2. Undertake and complete the goals for the development and establishment of the Master of Science program in Clinical Pharmacy.
 - 4.3. Provide the physical facilities and the human resources to ensure the quality of the curriculum and the program.
 - 4.4. Develop and implement a marketing strategy for promoting the program.
 - 4.5. Reimburse JSS University for the provision of services.
 - 4.6. Establish a video conference link between JSS University and Oman Medical College subject to feasibility and viability.
5. Subject to obtaining the required statutory approvals, it is envisaged to commence the program in the month of September 2013.
