THE LAST DOSE

CRIME SCENE INVESTIGATION

"Searching for the invisible poison"

The Rathore family lived in a wide, sunlit bungalow on Gulmohar Lane. Vikram Rathore—the man who built his textile empire from the ground up—was hosting the Grand Rathore Textiles Silver Jubilee Gala, meant to be a night of triumph. By the next morning, the mansion was wrapped in police tape.

It addresses pressing human rights issues, conducts reviews of member states, and fosters international cooperation to ensure fairness, transparency, and justice in all legal systems.

Agenda: Examining the Application of the Death Penalty and Promoting Fair, Transparent, and Legally Compliant Practices in Criminal Justice Systems Worldwide.

Furthermore, issues of disproportionate application based on race, socioeconomic status, or political affiliation undermine the integrity of justice systems globally. The committee will undertake a comprehensive examination of the judicial processes surrounding capital punishment, focusing on standards of fair trial, access to legal counsel, and judicial transparency. Delegates are called upon to review arguments for and against the use of the death penalty, and propose oversight mechanisms, promoting moratoriums, and ensuring that all criminal justice practices strictly adhere to international human rights standards and treaties.


