BSc Forensic Science

OBJECTIVES:

The programme aims to create graduates who will

- 2. Work and communicate effectively in inter-disciplinary environment, either independently or in a team, and demonstrate leadership qualities.
- 3. Will engage in life-long learning and professional development through self-study, continuing education or professional and doctoral level studies.

Outcome: After completing three years of B.Sc., Forensic Science course the graduate should be able to

- 1. To take part in a forensic investigation by providing experience of examining forensic evidence and case studies.
- 2. It exposes students to the appropriate information related to forensic science in the broad areas of criminal investigation, laws in relation to it scientific practical techniques involved so that they can acquire skills necessary to carry out independent work in the respective field.
