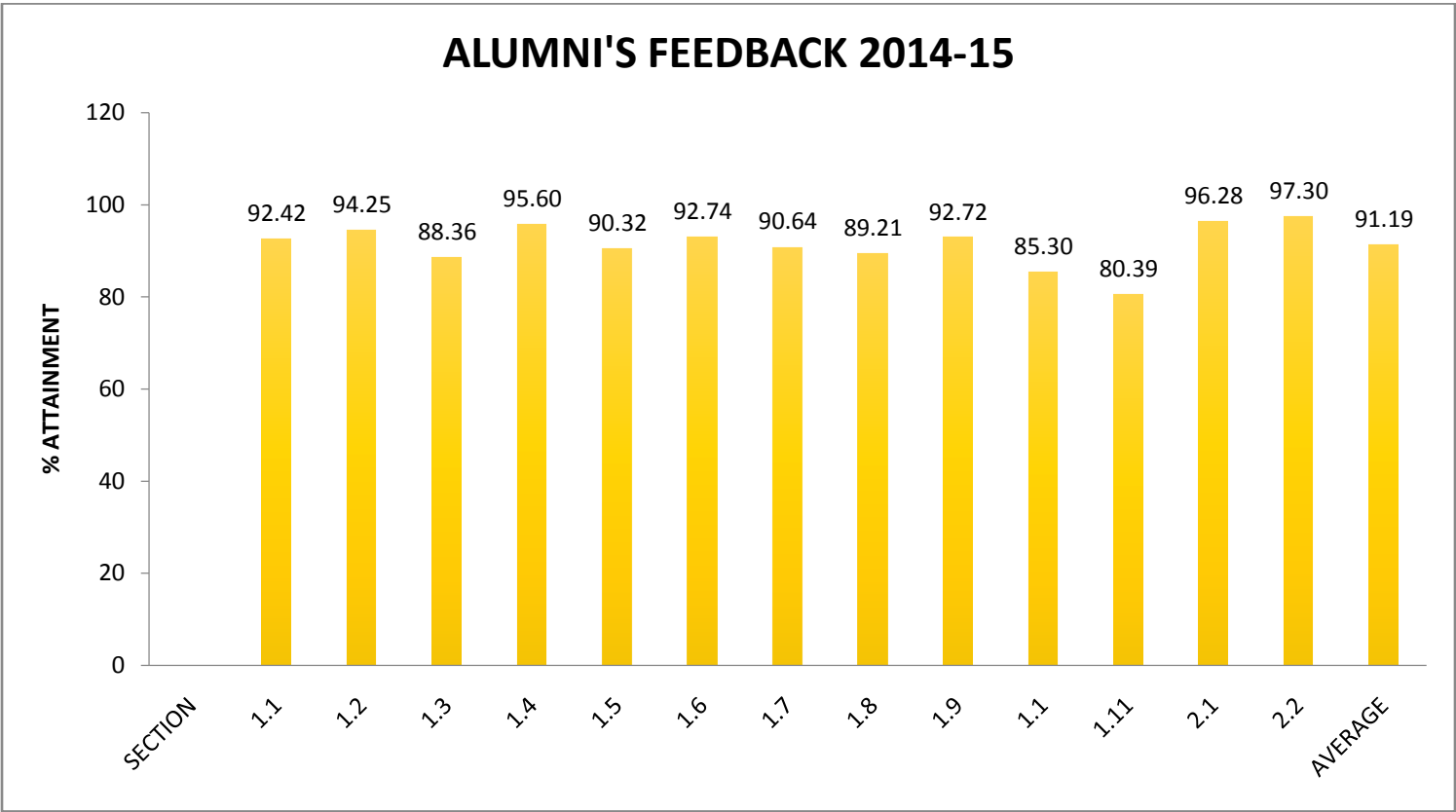

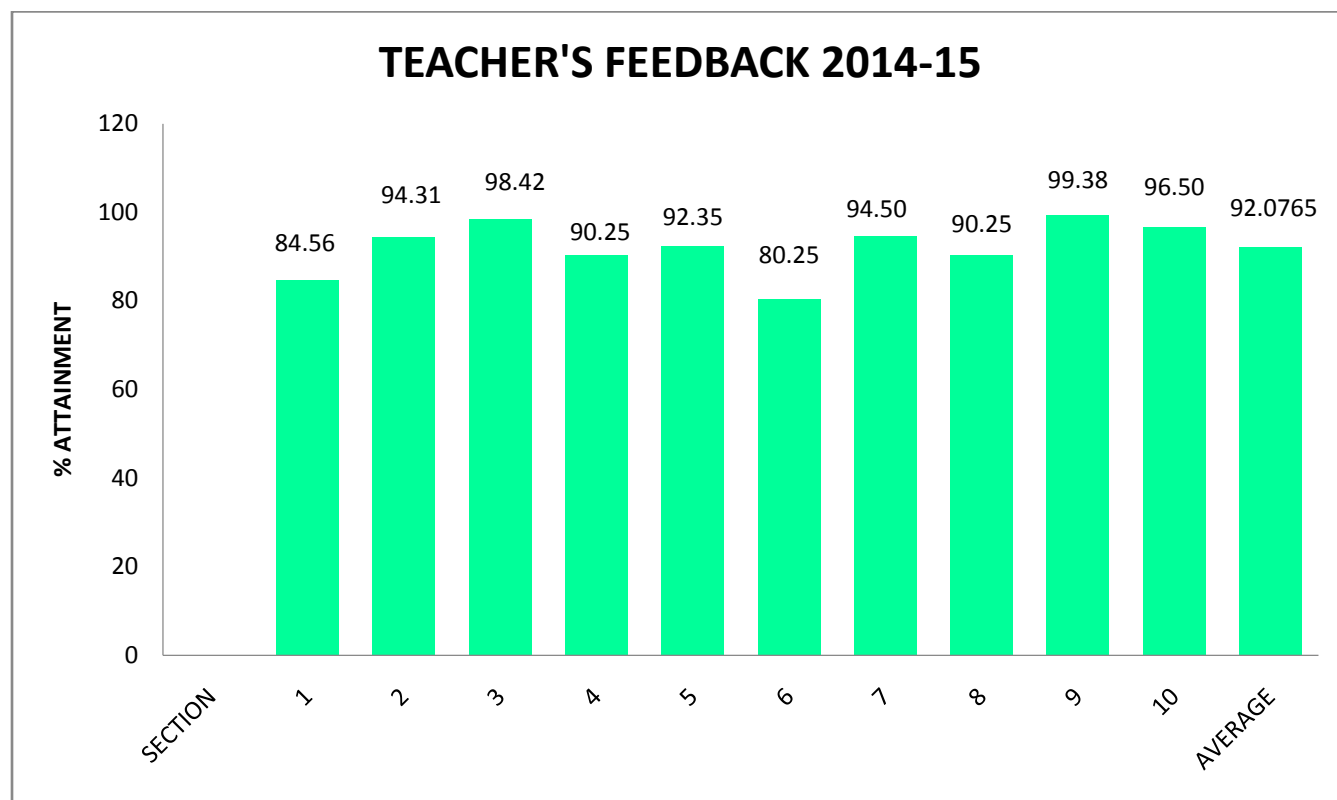
Graph – Alumni feedback

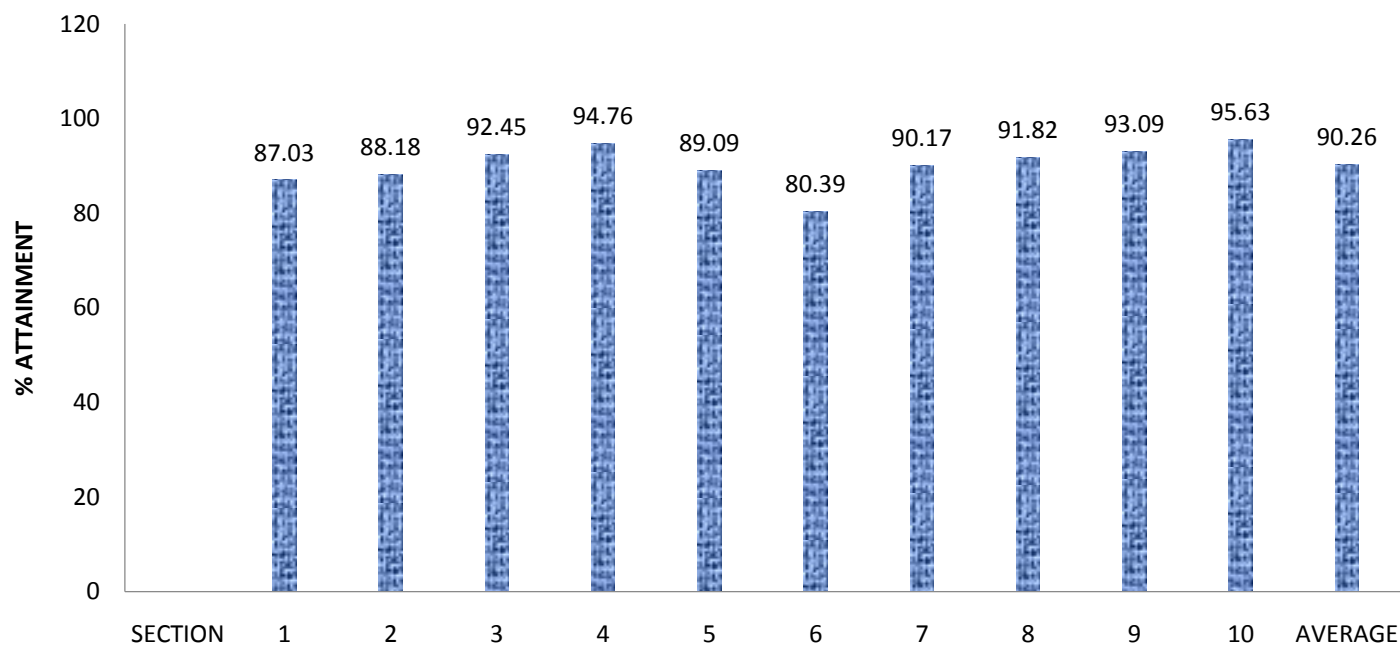
**Graph – Teachers feedback on curriculum**

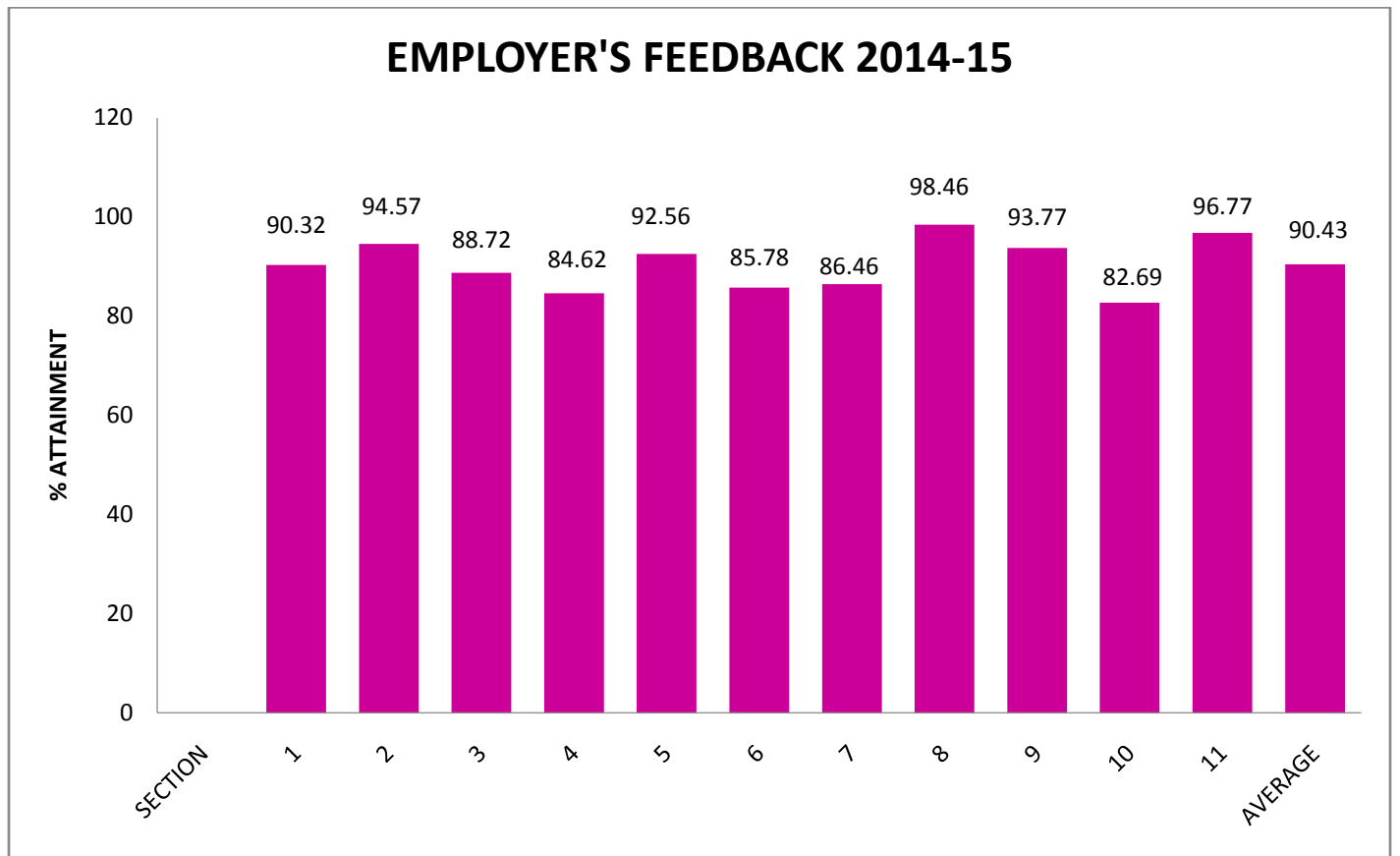

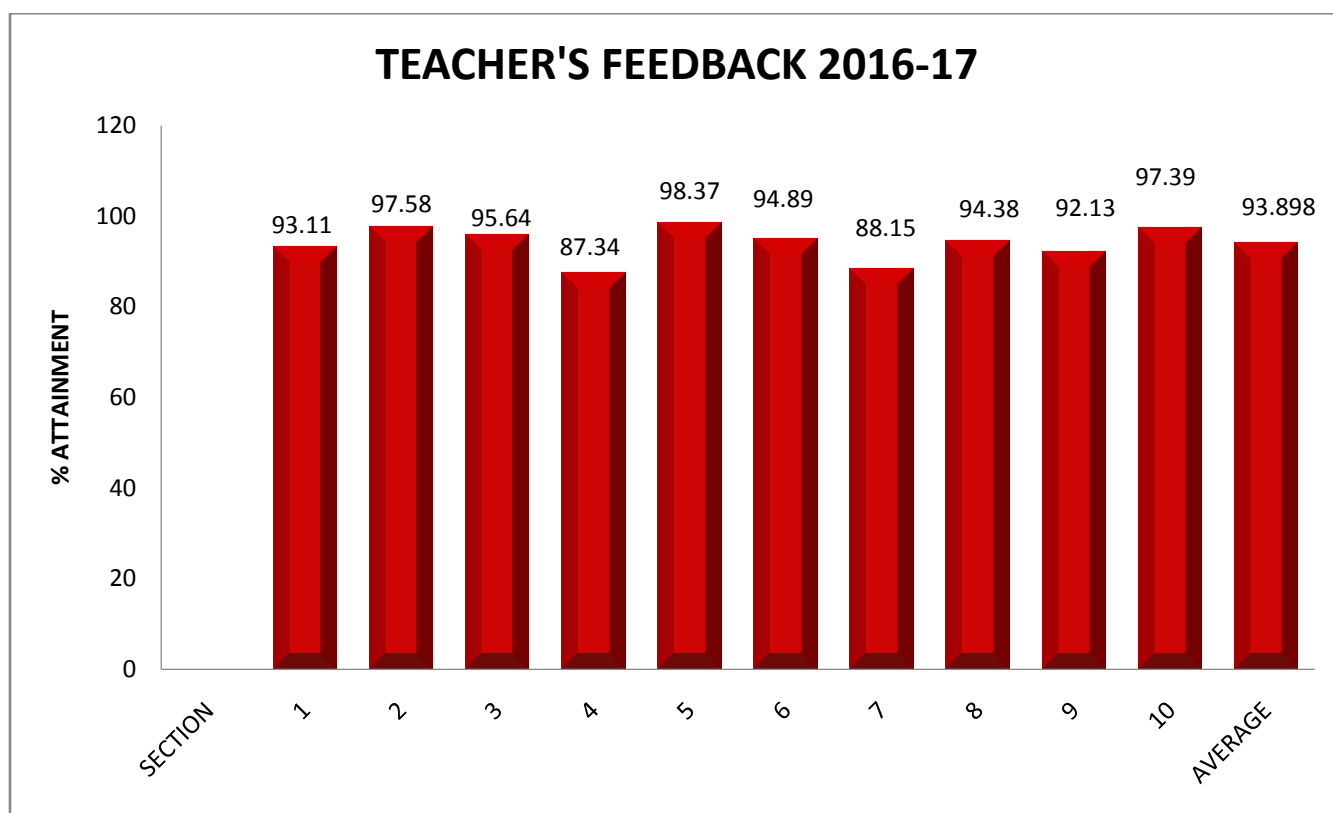
Graph – Alumni feedback

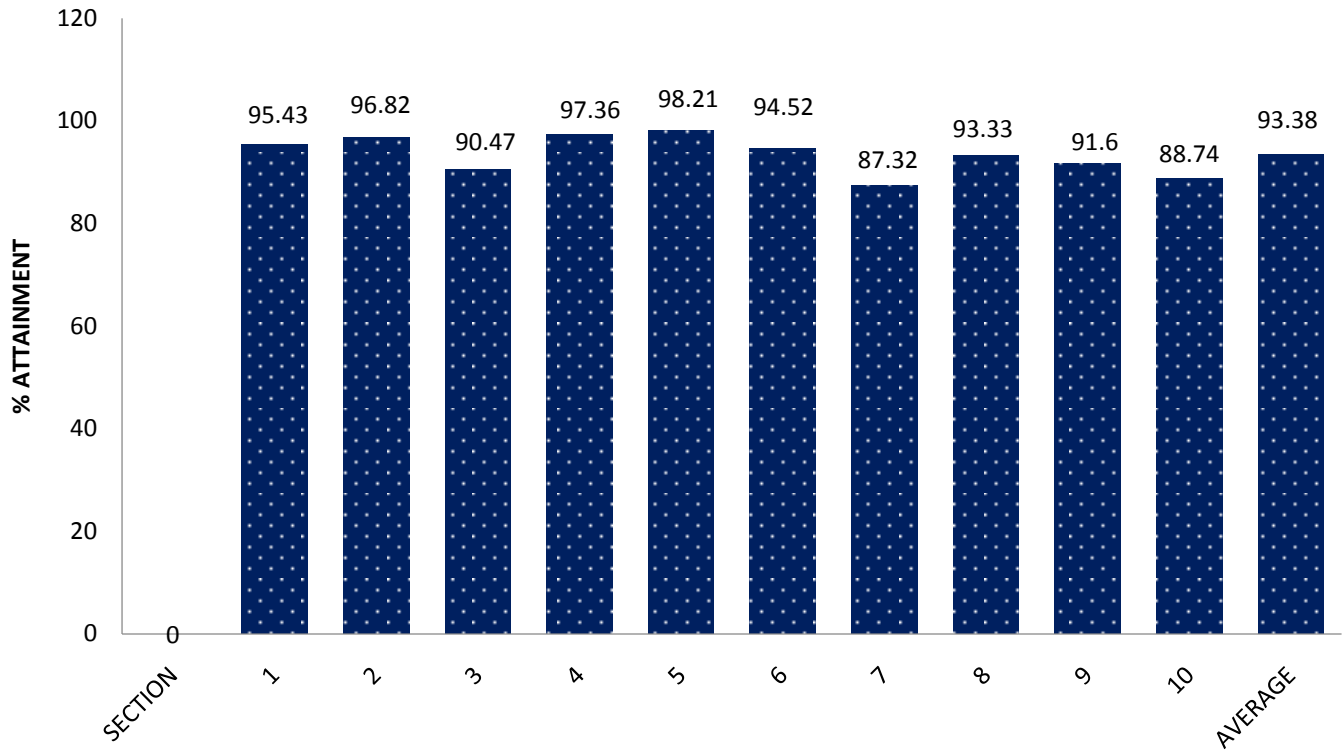
**Graph – Teachers feedback on curriculum**
