

Student's Feedback on Teachers (2014-15)




The faculty wise feedback of students for the year 2014-15 was analyzed. Through the graph depicted we can see that the faculties of Department of Paedodontics and Preventive Dentistry have the highest score of 4.08. The department of Oral medicine and Radiology has a score of 4.06 followed by Department of Perio with an average score of 3.99. Even the Dept of OMFS has a score of 3.95 following which Department of Ortho has a score of 3.91. The Department of cons has a score of 3.81 followed by the Department of Prostho, Public health dentistry and Oral pathology with scores of 3.78, 3.75 and 3.59. The Overall college average stands at 3.88 out of Five for the Year 2014-15.

After elaborate discussion in the HOD s Meeting it was decided that the college average could be increased by encouraging faculty to attend more numbers of TOT and conferences related to medical/dental education.

The possibility of conducting in-house training could also be thought about.


Exit students' feedback(on facilities, teaching quality and services) 2014-15



The Exit Level feedback was conducted at the exit level of both the UG and PG students. The feedback was collected on the requirements regarding facilities, curriculum, teaching quality & services. As the graph above depicts we can see that over all there is an average score of 87.45. And all the Criteria's mentioned in the feedback have score above 80% expect for the *student services where it was noted that the Hostel Facilities needed to be improved.*

After the discussion, the grievances about hostel was decided that the same should be communicated to the hostel warden.


Alumni's Feedback (On Professional competencies, curriculum and services) 2014-15



The Alumni s of the college had also provided their valuable inputs to the college. Through the above Graph we can see that an average score of 61.81 has been provided by the students.



Employer's Feedback (On attainment of course outcomes and students quality) 2014-15





Parent's Feedback (On facilities and learning environment) 2014-15




The feedback from the parents was also obtained for the year 2014-15. It was noted from the above graph that almost 90% of the parents are very satisfied with the facilities provided by the college.

Teacher's Feedback (On facilities, curriculum and HR Policies) 2014-15






Exit students' feedback(on facilities, teaching quality and services) 2015-16


After discussions, the facilities about hostel was decided that it should be communicated to the hostel warden.

Alumni's Feedback (On Professional competencies, curriculum and services) 2015-16





Employer's Feedback (On attainment of course outcomes and students quality) 2015-16




Employers feedback for the year 2015-16 shows improvement compared to the previous year with an average score of 89.94 compared to that of 89.66 in the previous year.

Parent's Feedback (On facilities and learning environment) 2015-16





Teacher's Feedback (On facilities, curriculum and HR Policies) 2015-16





Student's Feedback on Teachers (2016-17)





Alumni's Feedback (On Professional competencies, curriculum and services) 2016-17




Principal informed that some alumni have expressed the interest in certificate programmes implementation. Some have also given positive response for DORA.

Employer's Feedback (On attainment of course outcomes and students quality) 2016-17




Employers feedback for the year 2016-17 shows improvement compared to the previous year with an average score of 92.09 compared to that of 89.94 in the previous year.
