13. Conducted for Medicos

For creating awareness among medicos regarding breast feeding practices and Breast Feeding Week 2014, Quiz competition was conducted by National Service Scheme in collaboration with Department of Community Medicine, JSS Medical College, Mysore.

To begin with there were five teams each having four 7th term MBBS students. The quiz competition extended over a period of one hour. The first round was an elimination round wherein written test was conducted. One team was eliminated in this round and the

remaining four were moved into further rounds. The second round was a visual round consisting of multiple choice questions.

In the third round one student from each team had to pick up the topics that were written in the chits and give verbal clues regarding the topic (without directly using the words in the chit) and the rest of the team members had to guess the topic within the specified time. Once the team members guessed the topic they were given time to think about it and discuss among themselves for 30 sec, after which another student from the same team had to come on the dais and speak about the topic. Teams were judged on the basis of their depth of knowledge, level of confidence, relevance to the topic, time keeping and overall performance. At the end of this round two teams with least scores were eliminated. The final and the fourth round was a rapid fire round for the remaining two teams following which the winners and runners-up were announced.

Dr. Renuka M, Professor and head, Department of Community Medicine interacted with the students and cleared their doubts regarding breast feeding practices. This campaign was officially launched on 2 October 2014 at <u>Rajghat</u>, <u>New Delhi</u>, where Prime Minister <u>Narendra Modi</u> himself wielded broom and cleaned a road. DETAILED NARRATIVE REPORT

The NSS Unit of JSS Medical College has conducted the NSS special camp for villagers in Srinivasa Agrahara village of Srirangapatna Taluk. The camp was for the period of one week. On 15th march the inaugural function of the camp was held in the presence of dignitaries like Dr Sujay Kumar who emphasized the role of doctors in building the society, he also remembered his father who was a doctor in 1940's and said the medical care and technology has changed so much in which doctor and patient relationship propinquity has been diminished. He also suggested NSS volunteers to serve for the rural people and mainly service oriented attitude

should be developed within inside of us. Dr. H. Basavanagowdappa, Principal said that NSS was the Gandhiji's dream of building nation by the efficient utilization of youth of the country, the NSS volunteers should build good rapport with the villagers and create awareness regarding health and its importance among villagers. On 16-03-2015 the regular medical camp was started, on this day medicine specialty doctors came around 96 patients utilized the facilities. Free ECG, blood glucose monitoring, blood pressure monitoring and free medicines were distributed. On 17-03-2015 obstetrics and gynecology specialty clinic was there, around 87 patients had utilized the facilities. On 18-03-2015 pediatrics specialty clinic was there, around 99 patients came and in school children with malnutrition and other problems were addressed. On 19-03-2015 ENT, ophthalmology and dermatology specialty clinic was there, cataract cases were referred to JSS hospital for free eye operation and others were treated there only by outpatient management. On 20-03-2015 orthopedics and free dental check up camp organized, mobile dental bus came and did checkup and treatment for cases requiring filling and tooth extraction. The required medicines were dispensed free of cost and if further treatment was needed, were referred to JSS Hospital, Mysore. In addition other services like ECG and Blood glucose test were done. It is with pride that we state that a total of 556 patients received the benefit of these services and medicines were distributed free of cost to the patients.

The valedictory function was held on the 20th march 2015 Dr Balaraj vice principal spoke about successful camp and wished all villagers and NSS volunteers happy ugadi, Dr Gangadarappa NSS coordinator JSS university said that medical college is doing well. Dr Prashant, Dr Renuka, Dr Ashok, Dr Narayanmurthy, Dr Prakash and Mr Jayshankar were present.
